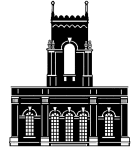


# Provisional Booking Form for Private Tours of the Water Tower or Carshalton House Gardens



## The Carshalton Water Tower

This beautiful Water Tower, which contains a unique & elegant suite of rooms, is a Grade II listed Georgian building. It is situated in the landscaped grounds of Carshalton House which the Trust shares with St Philomena's school and St Mary's Junior School in the heart of Historic Carshalton.

Inside the Water Tower, apart from the Pump Chamber, with its restored remains of the water wheel, which offers, industrial archaeological interest, there is the Bathroom, with limited access, which has a plunge bath & beautiful tile decoration. The charming alcoved Saloon offers a superb view across the garden to Carshalton House. The Robing Room has limited kitchen facilities & a toilet that is suitable for visitors in wheelchairs. The Orangery completed this fascinating complex. The roof, which offers views of the grounds & part of Carshalton, is available under certain conditions.

## The Carshalton House Estate Garden

We have a tradition of conducting tailor-made private tours of the Water Tower &/or The Garden of the Carshalton House Estate to meet your needs. Whether you are historians, landscape/building architects, interested in the flora & fauna or would just like to visit a secret garden or unique building in Carshalton.

The Garden landscape is primarily 18th Century in design. It displays several early formal & later more romantic features. There are three fascinating gardens follies: A beautiful Water Tower, the Hermitage & the Folly Bridge. The Stations of the Cross are later in date & there is, on site, the location of a World War II early warning station

Refreshments may also be provided, from tea/coffee/juice, cream teas, to buffet lunch, to meet your needs.  
Refreshments must be booked prior to the event and are normally served in the Water Tower.
